Chapter Two: Major Pentatonic. The Major Pentatonic Scale is a more useful way of improvising in a major tonality than a pure major scale. The scale leaves out the perfect fourth and the seventh. The perfect fourth being a semitone above the major third can create a dissonant sound and should be used selectively.
