An elementary understanding of anatomy, physiology, and bacteriology, as usually presented to nurses, is assumed. No attempt is made to cover these subjects, except in a few instances to emphasize certain relations to surgical conditions. The course covers the general principles of surgical diseases and the pathological changes which result. Also, under separate headings, the more important surgical lesions involving special regions of the body, are considered. The matter is presented simply, and only general statements are made concerning: 1. Etiology, causal factors. 2. Pathology, local tissue changes produced, and general effects. 3. Natural course of the disease and spontaneous attempts to control the condition, also factors influencing the prognosis. 4. Indications for treatment, and the general principles which are to be considered. No attempt is made to discuss technical nursing methods, except special indications for their use.
