First sentences vary in their attempts to interest readers in the paragraph, page, chapter and book. Some first lines use description to build tension from line one.

Establish the tone. The first page of your novel should give the reader a sense of your story's tone. If you're trying to write a bestselling thriller, you'll likely want a dark, brooding tone that leads us to a cliffhanger.
