In the next line, parts of speech label ([n.] for nouns and [v.] for verbs) and the entry 's Chinese equivalents in Pinyin (Romanized standard Chinese pronunciation) followed by Chinese characters (both simplified and traditional if applicable). A syllable is part of a word that contains one vowel sound. In every word of two or more syllables, one syllable is stressed. It 's called 'stressed syllable'. The vowel sound in that syllable is louder, higher in pitch, and longer than the other vowel sounds in the same word. The contrast between stressed and unstressed syllables is very important because it helps to create the rhythm of English. The native English speakers rely more on stressed syllable to understand what you say than on the individual sounds of the word.
