"When We Two Parted" was written in 1816 by the British Romantic poet Lord Byron. It describes the pain and disillusionment that follow a break-up between the speaker and his lover. Though little detail is provided, it's implied that the original relationship was secret—most likely an extramarital affair—and that the speaker now feels bitter upon hearing about his lover having an affair with someone else.

Language: " They name thee before me, a knell to mine ear " : Towards the end the narrator says the relationship is like death. Emphasizes lack of feeling for him. Name reminds him of the death of their relationship. " When we two parted " : The personal pronoun of " we " makes the poem more personal. Contrasts with use of " They name " in stanza 3 showing he felt a bond between him and his lover which made them different from everyone else.
